In a previous Preceptor, Brother Matt McKinney spoke about our responsibility of bringing in two new members to DeMolay, one to replace us when we age out, and one to make the Order grow. Please realize that this is a minimum! You can bring as many new members into your chapter as you want!

QUIZ: What is the highest number of new members ever brought into DeMolay by a single member? Bonus points for providing his name.

New applicants are asked for the names of 3 friends on the petition. These names should become character references during the investigation process. They should be contacted and asked some serious questions about the applicant, which serves a dual purpose. First, we learn about the applicant. But secondly, and maybe more importantly, we are giving those three guys a huge impression that DeMolay is a quality organization and that we care about who joins. Those three guys are going to start asking questions of the applicant and become instant prospects themselves.

We historically ask Masons and other adults for the names of young men who might be interested in joining. I would like to ask you for the names of some adults that you feel would make good Advisors. We need qualified men and women to help the chapters exist. Some chapters have focused their recruitment efforts on father/son teams from other organizations like Boy Scouts, Indian Guides, NJB basketball, etc. In those instances the father usually gets involved with the Advisory Council and, in many cases, has gone on to become a Mason. Please speak with your Chapter Dad or Chairman if you know of a qualified adult who might like to work with us.

Keep up the good work! Membership is up, participation is up, and the whole Jurisdiction is looking better each day because of your efforts. Thank you for making us look good, and I look forward to seeing you at the next event.

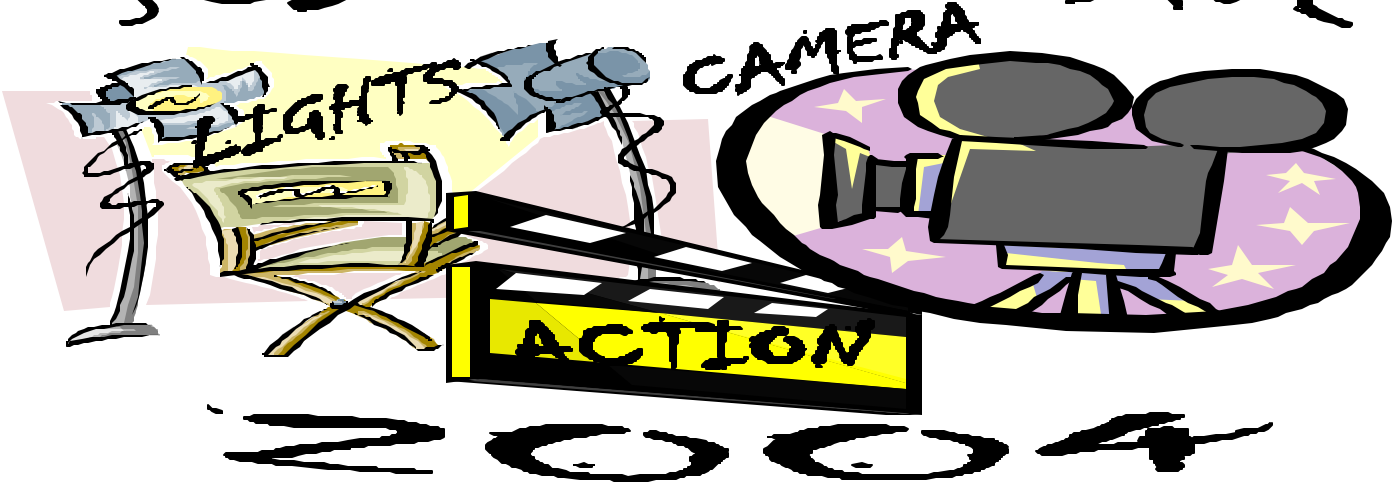
Jurisdiction Dad

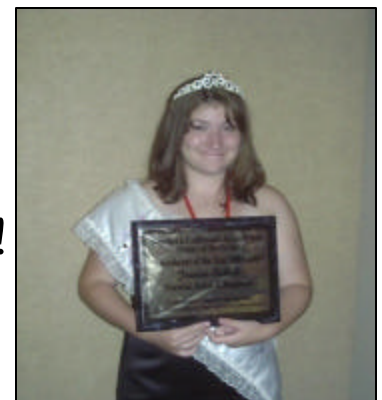
