



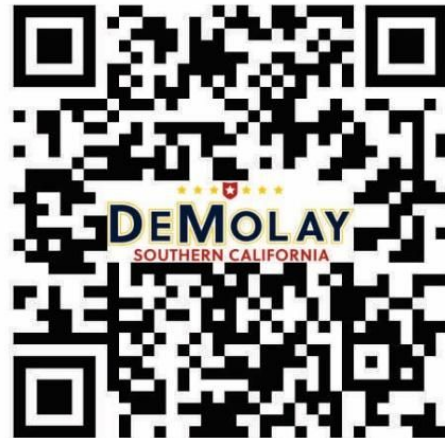

[MISSION OBJECTIVES]

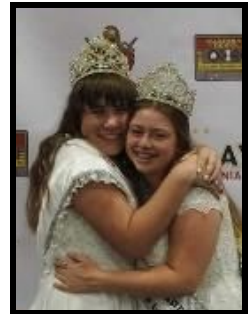
